## **PLAN OF STUDY**

Once students receive an offer of admission to a graduate program and confirms their intention to enroll, they should meet with their assigned adviser to review the Plan of Study, which is available via <a href="my.newpaltz.edu">my.newpaltz.edu</a>. The Plan of Study lists all of the courses that will comprise the student's degree program. Only two courses below B- (2.67 on the 4.00 scale) are counted toward a graduate degree. Matriculated students with four or more grades below B- will forfeit their matriculated status. Please note that neither undergraduate courses nor graduate courses with a grade of F may be included on a graduate Plan of Study.

The advisor may make minor plan amendments by submitting an online Plan Amendment Request, which must be approved by the Associate Provost and Dean of GPIS.
